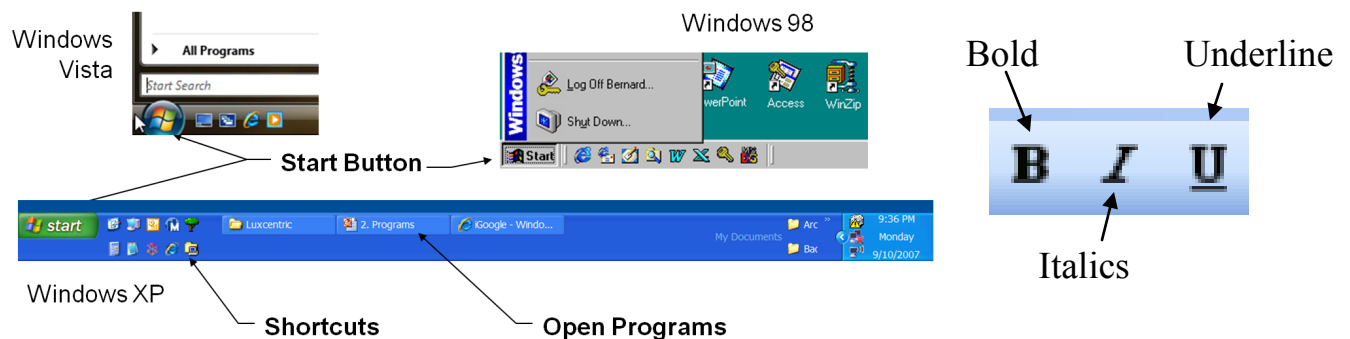
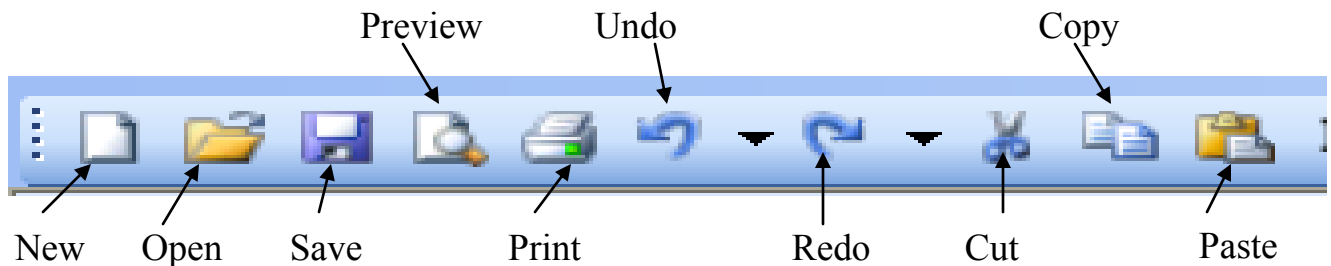


# Changes:
